In May 1775, he was elected commander in chief of the Continental Army.	
1st president to name an African American cabinet member, Robert Weaver, HUD	
He was the first president to give a speech on television	
He was the first president to speak over the radio.	
First President to open a Baseball Season	
He was the first president to die in office, 32 days after he was elected.	
He was the only president to be an eagle scout	
Lincoln was the only president to receive a patent, for a device for lifting boats over shoals	
Only President who never married. His niece Harriet Lane acted as First Lady.	
He was the only president to resign from office.	
He was the only President to serve who was not elected by U.S. voters either as President or Vice President.	
His favorite horse was named Nelson.	
He loved to play the violin	
He kept a parrot in the White House that could whistle "Yankee Doodle." McKinley would whistle the first part, and the bird would finish it.	
He owned two tiger cubs as pets.	
He was an avid fisherman	
He was the only President born in Illinois
